Her major interest is the role of the CNS in regulating feeding behavior and energy homeostasis. Her lab is focused on particular hypothalamic-striatal pathways and in particular on the role of the hormone leptin and the neuropeptide MCH in modulating motivated behavior. We integrate changes in observed behavior with changes in gene expression and signaling pathways and neuronal electrophysiology.
